Update from Alex: I am having a tough time. I'm recovering fairly well from my brain surgery, but really struggling with my endometriosis. My doctor tested some polyps he removed for endometrial cancer and didn't find any, but is putting me on a 3-6 month treatment of a chemo medicine that will ensure there isn't any and hopefully reverse my endometriosis too. The side effects are fairly brutal and I'm really struggling to eat and sleep and manage pain. I am praying for some relief soon but am thankful the brain surgery is healing well!!
